You will study life in Nazi Germany and the causes of WW2. You will study the leadership of Winston Churchill and a local history study of Coventry during the Blitz.

1933 to 1939 – the rise of Nazism in Germany

You will examine the Rise of Hitler. You will describe the steps by which he was able to become leader of Germany. You will explain what life was like for different groups under Nazi rule

You will explain the causes of WWI and the features of life in the trenches and on the Home Front. You will examine surgical developments in WWI and write an account of life in the trenches. You will explain the key features of the Versailles Peace Settlement and the consequences..

You will explain why Britain wanted an Empire. You will then study and examine the experiences of different countries within the Empire such as India, Africa and Australia. You will then come to a judgement on the Empire, was it a positive force or a negative one?

Britain 1750-1900

You will assess the changes in Britain in the years 1750-1900. This will include the impact of rapid industrialisation on the landscape as well as ordinary peoples lives. The fight for change will also be examine through key events such as Peterloo and the Luddites
