1558 to 1603 Elizabethan England

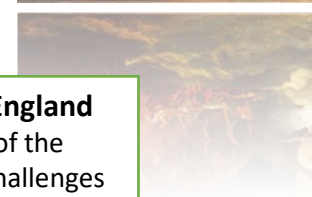

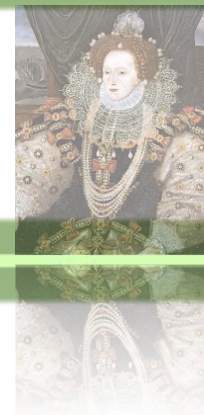
