Skills covered: Use of scripture and other sources of authority, contrasting scientific and/or nonreligious world-views such as those held by Atheists and Humanists

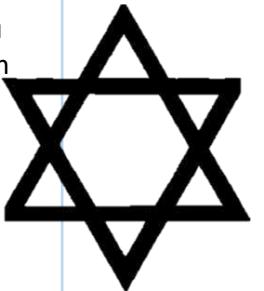

Judaism- Practices

You will consider Jewish Practices and how they impact on your faith. You will review different types of Jews and explore the Synagogue. Develop an understanding of Jewish worship and prayer. Explore the significance of Shekinah, Torah, Talmud and other key scripture. Engage with key Jewish initiation ceremonies and significant festivals- Brit Milah, Marriage, Funerals, Yom Kipper.

Skills Covered: Evaluate the importance of different religious beliefs and teachings in relation to practices – looking at two different sides of an argument and be able to express opinion.
