You will learn the different attributes of God. You will look at the opposing arguments and those written by Philosophers to prove the existence of God.

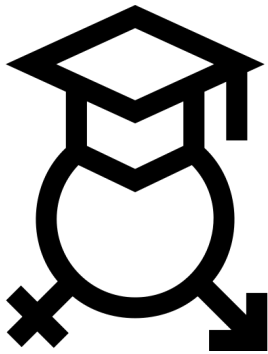

Skills covered – recall, research, investigation and group work

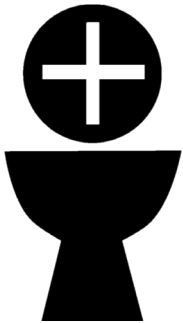
