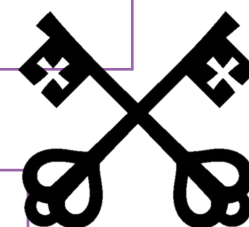

You will learn who Jesus was, what people thought of him and the attributes he had. You will also learn about key events in Jesus' life.

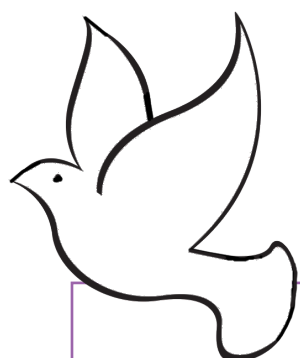
Skills covered - literacy skills, recall skills, interpretation of the Bible, independent and peer work skills.
