Your son/daughter should arrive in school at **8.50am and enter through the main front gates OR via the Cinder Path pedestrian gate. The Tamworth Road gate <u>will not be open</u>. On arrival, they will be met by members of staff and will be directed to their signing in location before meeting their tutor in the Pope Francis Hall. Please note that parents should <u>not</u> come onto site at the beginning of the day.**

All students should attend in their primary school uniform. Lunch will be provided for all pupils but pupils are welcome to bring in their own packed lunch.

As you may be aware, Cardinal Newman is a very large site with many exits. To ensure a safe dismissal at the end of the day, Cardinal Newman staff will escort **Christ the King** students to <u>Coundon Park MAIN car</u> <u>park.</u> We kindly ask that all parents/carers park and wait here to collect their son/daughter. <u>Please collect</u> <u>pupils at 2.40pm from Coundon Park MAIN Car Park.</u>

Please note that vehicles are NOT allowed on school site at the end of the day.
