Dear Parents/Carers

We hope you have enjoyed the summer break, and we look forward to students returning to school next week.

Please see below a reminder of the school return dates for each year group:

We would like to remind parents of the high expectations regarding school uniform and being prepared for learning before the start of the new term. Also a reminder that the school day will finish at 3.00pm from September.

Students are expected to always comply with the school uniform policy.

Uniform:

- Black school shoes. <u>Trainers</u>, boots or canvas shoes are <u>not</u> acceptable. School shoes are not made by sports brands.
- Black <u>tailored</u> trousers. Jeans, <u>tight-fitting trousers</u> or leggings are <u>not</u> permitted.
- School blazers are compulsory.
- School jumper and tie.
- Black school skirt must be of an appropriate length for school and pleated.
- Socks should be plain black, white or grey with no branding or adornments e.g. bows.

Students must not wear:

- Jewellery, other than a watch and one small pair of stud earrings. If your child has piercings, they should wear a clear retainer.
- Nail varnish or acrylic nails.
- Bright, unnatural hair colours.

Please ensure that your child has the correct uniform on the first day back. Students who arrive in incorrect

Equipment:

Students must be equipped for learning and should have the following:
