We are writing to share the arrangements for students collecting their examination results this summer.

Due to the ongoing roadworks on Sandpits Lane and our transition into the new school building, which is currently undergoing final preparations, access to the school site will be restricted this year.

At the time of writing, Sandpits Lane remains closed to vehicles from the Bennetts Road South entrance and is only accessible via Tamworth Road for business access to the Golf Range. We therefore advise parents and carers who are dropping students off to do so on Bennetts Road South, allowing students to walk along Sandpits Lane to access the school car park.

Please note that no vehicles will be permitted on site during the results collection period. Students should enter the site on foot via the former vehicle exit and pedestrian gate, where they will be directed to the school canteen to collect their results. For health and safety reasons, there will be no access to the new school building, as contractors are continuing work within the premises.

To help ensure a smooth and efficient process for all students, we kindly ask that students attend within their allocated time slot. We would also be grateful for your cooperation with the temporary access arrangements, which are necessary during this important period of transition.
