Cardinal Newman undertakes a number of activities with local employers to support our students in giving them a useful perspective on what the world of work is like, to help them identify transferrable skills, to improve their employability, to broaden horizons and to raise aspirations.

Mock Interview Days

Students in Year 11 each receive a mock interview with an employer. Students are supported to compile a CV and complete an application for an apprenticeship vacancy before being interviewed for that vacancy.

Visiting Speakers

Speakers from a range of industries are invited to speak to our students about their work, what's involved, entry routes and the importance of education in getting there

Work-Experience

Y10 students on vocational courses will be sent on work-experience as will all Y12 students to gain an insight into work.

Apprenticeship Fare

Over 30 employers and training providers are invited to an event to allow students to understand opportunities available to them, entry routes and requirements etc
