

Apprenticeship Support

Students at Cardinal Newman are encouraged to consider all of their options for both Post-16 and Post 18 and Apprenticeships are a big part of this.

During blanket careers interviews during Years 11 and 12 students will discuss Apprenticeships as one of their main options for progression and during the year students in Year 11-13 will be offered support in applying for vacancies as follows:

Small Group Sessions

Register on the National Apprenticeship Service website, and sign up for alerts to ensure students are receiving the latest vacancies.

Applications via local and national training providers to be put forward for their vacancies (e.g. MGTS, Heart of England Training, CWT, MTC, ProVQ, WGTA, JTL, Coventry College & Warwickshire College) dependant on student interests.

Individual Support

Support in finding appropriate vacancies
Support with applying for individual vacancies

Support to prepare and undergo for on-line assessments and psychometric testing
