## Code of Conduct Information – Year 11 Leavers' Prom 2023

The following behaviour is expressly forbidden and may result in students being sent home or collected at parental expense:

- Failure to follow instructions from school or hotel staff
- Purchase, possession or consumption of alcohol, drugs or tobacco/cigarettes (before or during the Leavers' Prom)
- Disorderly or violent conduct.
- Disregard or damage to the property or possessions of others.

Please discuss the Code of Conduct and the school's expectations for behaviour during this event with your son/daughter.

Students and parents/carers must sign the Code of Conduct below agreeing to follow the above rules and any instructions given by staff. The Code of Conduct MUST be completed and returned when a Prom ticket is purchased. It is also key that you complete the section advising on method of transport home.

No ticket will be sold to any student unless a completed Code of Conduct is presented at time of purchase. The Prom is strictly entrance by ticket only!
