**Re: Year 11 Arrangements for Final Exams- Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June**

As we come to the end of the examination period, we are writing to inform of the arrangements for Year 11 students on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June which will be the last exams for a large majority of students and their final day in school.
