Getting to and from school



It is so important that before you start with us at CNCS, you know how you will get to and from school. You should practise this journey with your parents/carers for September.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: There is no longer be a school bus service that comes onto school site (from September 2022).

There are a few ways you may get to school:

1. Walking

If you live within walking distance, walking to school is the best option. You may access the site via our pedestrian gates located on Bennetts Road (Cinder Path) or Tamworth Road.

2. Vehicle drop off on school site



If you are getting dropped off in a car/vehicle, you can access via the top vehicle gate. You must be on site before 8.20am. No vehicles are permitted after this time.

3. Bus (off school site)

If you live a little further away, you might need to get a busefrom school. The nearest bus stops are as follows, along with the bus timetables and routes:

• Number 16 (Bennetts Road, opposite the garage)

4. Cycling to school

You are allowing to cycle to school. We have a secure bicycle shed for you to use if you wish. There are a few rules however:

- You must be on site before 8.30am
- You MUST wear a cycling <u>helmet</u>
- You will be asked to sign a <u>cycling contract</u> in your first week
- You are NOT ALLOWED to cycle on site; you must walk with your bike from the pedestrian gate

Remember! You must be on school site before 8.30am.

- PRACTISE your route/bus journey and find the gate you will enter the site through
- See if any friends are walking to school or getting the busy- can you join them?
- Get your bus pass ready before September (if needed)
- Don't worry! It'll be fine
- Be prepared to tell your tutor how you are getting home on your first day- we will record this information.
