Trip to Shrewsbury Prison – 26th For Law and 28th for Criminology February 2024

We are delighted to confirm that we are able to offer students the chance to attend a visit to Shrewsbury Prison for Law and Criminology.

The aim of the trip is to give students a deeper understanding of Crime and punishment and recognise what it was like to be incarcerated from the Victorian era to the modern day. This will provide an insight into prison life which is part of their examination specification.

The plan is to depart from Cardinal Newman School at approximately 8.00am returning at approximately 4pm. Please ensure you make safe and suitable arrangements for your child to travel home from school after the trip.

The student experience starts with a guided tour where they will start in reception where prisoners were processed, taken along the wings, the cells, including the segregation units, exercise yards, healthcare and the execution room.

Student will also take part in two actives:

• PRISONER EXPERIENCE

Student will experience what it is like to be processed into prison. Handing over their belongings they will change into a prison order orange jumpsuit. (over their normal clothes)

• IN-CELL EXPERIENCE

Students will be split into small groups, allocated a cell and given an allotted time to escape solving puzzles and clues. This encourages collaborative working and is mentally challenging.

The approximate cost of the trip is £40 per student, which will include transportation, the cost of the visit, the experiences and lunch.
