## **YEAR 8 SPANISH**

<u>Rationale:</u> The aim in year 8 is to build upon what they learnt in year 7, cement and deepen their knowledge and continue to expand students understanding and knowledge of the language by not only learning new structures and vocabulary but also practising in different context what they have previously learnt. One of the main focus will be the understanding of tenses, improvement of pronunciation and speaking tasks, and build up confidence in the use of longer sentences.

## A learner in year 8 will learn to:

**Grammar**: Revise the use of present tense of regular verbs: AR/ER/IR; understand how to use and form regular verbs in the past tense. Past tense of irregular verbs. Understand and use time expressions in the present, past and future. Give opinions in the past and justify them. Use comparatives. Use connectives to make more complex sentences. Future tense: ir + a+ infinitive.

<u>Topics</u>: Describe activities during a holiday in the past and give opinions about it. Discuss what food he/ she likes/ dislikes, what he/ she eats in every meal and also what he/she is planning to buy/do for a future party. Be able to order food in a restaurant/cafe. Express what he/she uses the mobile for, what he/she watches in the TV, give and justify opinions on TV programmes and music. Explain what he/ she did yesterday.

**Skills**: use and recognise the previous topics in the 4 skills: listening, reading, speaking and writing.
