

YEAR 9 SPANISH

Rationale: Building upon the foundations of years 7 and 8 French, year 9 learners will continue to deepen their knowledge and understanding of the language by revisiting language structures and vocabulary whilst putting them into practice. They will be able to use and understand different tenses in their own writing of the language and speaking skills.

A learner in year 9 will learn to:

Grammar: use with more confidence the present tense of regular and irregular verbs; use and form regular verbs in the past tense and use some irregular verbs. Understand when to use each tense and use them with increasing accuracy. Understand and use a wide variety of verbs of opinion, time expressions, quantifiers and frequency words. Use comparatives; use “querer/ poder” in the present tense; use a wide variety of connectives to make complex sentences in different tenses; understand, use and recognise negative words. Use the future tense: ir + a+ infinitive.

Topics:

- Describe what he/ she use/ used computers for; and understand/ read about this. Say/ write about/ recognise vocabulary on:
- The Media: give and justify opinions on TV programmes and types of films, and compare them. Say/ write about / recognise what he/ she did yesterday; and understand/ read about somebody talking about these topics: PC, TV and films.
- Work: earning and spending money, talking about what they would like to do in the future, jobs and what to do if winning the lottery.
- Health and healthy lifestyles: Talk about illness; give and understand advice on health & healthy living. Discuss healthy and unhealthy eating.

Skills: use and recognise the previous topics in the 4 skills: listening, reading, speaking and writing.
