Loudmouth is an innovative theatre in education company. They run relationships and safeguarding programmes to support students Personal, Social, Health and Economic education through interactive drama performances and workshops.

- Each year group (excluding Year 11) will have a loudmouth session which is age relevant to compliment their PSHE curriculum.
- It runs alongside when students are completing their RSE sessions in the curriculum plan
- Students watch an hour-long performance and then follow this up with a small group workshops to discuss and explore the topics further
- The sessions finish with students being provided with information on where they can get further information and help on the topics discussed
