The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives state-funded schools, including special schools and alternative provision settings, additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). The funding is calculated on the number of students who fell below the benchmark level 4 in English or Mathematics during the 2015 KS2 SATs test, which is then scaled to the number of students currently in year 7. The Senior Leader responsible for overseeing our pupil premium students is Assistant Headteacher, Mr Nicholas Versey (nicholas.versey@cncs.school)

What are our Principles?

Through our work as a Catholic School it is our firm belief that all students should have access to the basic standards of English and Mathematics and that any who fail to meet the expected standard at KS2 are then supported when they arrive to secondary school.

In our context and under the changes from the KS2 testing, we define a Literacy or Numeracy catch up student as one who has achieved a standardised score in their KS2 Reading or Mathematics papers which is below 100.
