We would like to remind parents of the high expectations regarding school uniform and being prepared for learning before the start of the new term.

Students are expected to always comply with the school uniform policy.

## Uniform:

- Black school shoes. **Trainers**, boots or canvas shoes are **not** acceptable. School shoes are not made by sports brands.
- Black **tailored** trousers. Jeans, **tight-fitting trousers** or leggings are **not** permitted.
- School blazers are compulsory.
- School jumper and tie.
- Black school skirt – must be of an appropriate length for school and pleated.
- Socks should be plain black, white or grey with no branding or adornments e.g. bows.

## Students must not wear:

- Jewellery, other than a watch and one small pair of stud earrings. If your child has piercings, they should wear a clear retainer.
- Nail varnish or acrylic nails.
- Bright, unnatural hair colours.

Please ensure that your child has the correct uniform on the first day back. Students who arrive in incorrect uniform will not access lessons and parents will be contacted.
