**Re: Information from the Schools Policing Team**

We hope you are well at the time.

The Schools' Policing Team have asked all schools in Coventry to share an important message with all students and their parents regarding acceptable behaviour on the last day of school before the end of the summer Term.

*As we look forward to the last day of term and the excitement of the summer break, we want to remind all students travelling through the city centre to ensure that they make their way home quickly and avoid lingering in large groups.*

*We know most students are very well behaved, but we have previously had incidents of antisocial behaviour such as littering, drug-taking, damaging property, as well as shop theft and violence in the city centre and in surrounding areas across the city.*

*The job of the Schools' Policing Team is to keep everybody safe. As a result, there will be an increase in police officers in the city centre and at transport hubs, as well as travelling on school bus routes. They will also be using CCTV to monitor larger groups of young people in the city. This is to make sure that the last day of term is safe, enjoyable, and free from trouble.*

*Thank you for your cooperation. We hope that you enjoy the summer holidays. Our school link officers will be in the city centre on patrol so if you require any information about summer activities happening in the city over the summer, please feel free to approach them.*

*Remember, there are lots of Safe Spaces in the city centre too, where students can go if they are worried or need support. Staff are trained to help, so look out for the Child Friendly Cov Safe Spaces stickers in the window of establishments in the city centre. Stay Safe.*
