Coventry Music Instrumental Music Lessons.

We are delighted to be able to offer Guitar and Piano lessons at Cardinal Newman School.

Having instrumental music lessons with Coventry Music has never been easier!

The signing up process can now be done via the online link

The Direct Billing option enables those receiving lessons to deal directly with Coventry Music as the provider. This can be beneficial in supporting the wider musical journey of your children. Please note that requests will be processed to start in September 2025. Payments will be collected over 12 months.

Prices are:-

Lesson Type	Cost (per month over 12 months)
Individual 30 min lesson (33 weeks)	£59.13 (total cost £709.50)
Individual 20 min lesson (33 weeks)	£39.42 (total cost £473)
Individual 30 min lesson fortnightly (17 weeks)	£30.46 (total cost £365.50)
Shared Lesson (20 minutes 2 pupils) (30 minutes 3 pupils)	£19.71 (total cost £236.50)

Please note that due to payments being on a pro rata basis, these prices may differ slightly to those previously advised by the school.

Through direct links with Coventry Music as well as more direct contact with your music tutor, Coventry Music will signpost you to out of school music groups, performances and other activity to develop, support and enhance the music provision both in school and through instrumental/vocal lessons. These lessons will take place during the school day in either an individual or shared/group lesson.
