Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope you and your family are well and that your child has made a settled and positive start at their new school during this first half term.

As we begin the first assessment period of the year, we want to share with you how we will be reporting on your child's progress throughout the academic year. This letter explains what you can expect from our data reporting process and how it will keep you informed about your child's learning journey.

Progress Reporting Overview

Over the course of the year, you will receive three formal progress reports: in the autumn, spring, and summer terms.

Autumn & Spring Progress Reviews

In the autumn and spring terms, you will receive progress reviews based on in-class assessments. These reports will include:

- Your child's percentage score in each subject assessment
- The class average percentage score for each subject, so you can see how your child is performing compared to their peers
- An Attitude to Learning score reflecting your child's behaviour and engagement

The percentage scores represent how your child performed in the test. Including the class average helps provide context for their progress within the group.

Summer Progress Review

In the summer term, the report will provide a more detailed overview of your child's progress throughout the year. In addition to the percentage assessment data, you will also receive:

- Numerical 'working at' grades for core subjects and selected others
- Age-related expectations and outcomes for remaining subjects
- A pastoral overview including behaviour and attendance information

This summer report gives a fuller picture of your child's achievements and development across both academic and pastoral areas.

We value the strong partnership between school and home and are committed to maintaining clear and ongoing communication throughout the year.
