**Re: Year 10 English Language Mock Result**

We hope that you are well at this time.

Please find enclosed a copy of your child's recent English Language Mock Examination result, along with a corresponding teacher forecast grade.

- **Mock Result:** This is the graded outcome from the mock result, calculated using internal grade boundaries.
  - The decimal point indicates the student's proximity to the next grade boundary. For example, a result of **4.9** suggests the student was very close to achieving a grade 5, while **4.0** suggests they were near the boundary between grades 3 and 4.
- **Teacher Forecast:** This is the predicted grade for your child's achievement at the end of Year 10. It indicates the result they are likely to achieve if they continue working with the same level of effort and commitment.
- **Aim High Target:** This is an aspirational target based on statistical data specific to your child.


Component 1 – Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> May 2026 (AM)
