Your child has now completed their Spring assessments, and we are pleased to share their **Spring Progress Review**, which accompanies this letter. These assessments help teachers identify your child's strengths, as well as any areas where further support may be needed.

In this review, you will find:

- Your child's percentage score for each subject
- The class average percentage for each assessment
- An Attitude to Learning score (7-1)
- Attendance and punctuality information

These elements together provide a clear picture of how your child has engaged with their learning this term and how their progress sits in relation to the wider cohort.

Students will now be reflecting on their results during tutor time and setting targets for their next steps. These targets will be recorded in their personal organiser on page 114. We kindly ask that you review and sign this section to support ongoing discussions at home.
