Dear parents and carers

Updates to examinations - 7th February 2022

We hope that you and your families are well at this time.

Ofqual have released important information regarding public examinations for the summer series 2022. To support students who have been affected by Covid-19, Ofqual have given guidance on examinations including focus topics, text types and formulae sheets that can be taken into the examinations.

Whilst like most schools, we would have preferred this information sooner, we have planned for a rapid response at this time to ensure that our year 10 students are well prepared for their GCSE Biology and English Language Exams this summer.

Biology Exam Updates

All pupils will be given a topic booklet that details the content that is; being assessed, not being assessed, and may appear in low tariff questions or via 'linked' questions. Linked questions are those that bring together knowledge, skills and understanding from across the specification.

English Language Exam Updates

Mock Exams will take place on Thursday 10th March (Biology) and Friday 11th March (English). These exams will give students the opportunity to experience first-hand, the organisational skills required when sitting the summer examinations.

These examinations will produce a valuable snap shot of where students' current learning sits in relation to the Ofqual guidance. The analysis of the mock examinations will allow a rapid response to plug any gaps in knowledge. After the mock exams there is a 7 week countdown until the summer examinations which will take place on; Biology- 17th May and 15th June and English Language- 18th May and 10th June.
