Dear Parent/Carer

RE: Year 13 Progress Review and Mock Exam Results

We hope you and your family are well at this time.

Enclosed is the progress review for your child. It contains the most up-to-date information from subject teachers regarding their progress in the February Final Mock Examinations. We hope this will help to identify areas of strengths and weakness and enable students to tailor their revision plan accordingly. The Parents' Consultation on **Thursday 10th March** will be an opportunity to discuss the results, Controlled Assessments and any modifications that have been made to summer examination content.

The main tranch of external examinations will take begin on Monday 23 May. This leaves eight teaching weeks to prepare. To help students recognise the importance of the remaining revision and preparation time, we have indicated whether (based on their mock results) they would have achieved their university place or be in Clearing. In the summer examination results will be published on Thursday 18th August.

It is important that moving forward students commit to a detailed revision timetable. They should also be accessing Period 6 lessons and any planned revision sessions. Students can also use study facilities in school during their independent study periods or stay behind after school to use the library or Lecture Theatre. This may also be a time for students to reduce part-time work commitments.

To help support your child tutor sessions and assemblies will all be directed towards examination preparation. We also have an external company Elevate Education in school on 31st March working on revision and memory skills. Subject teachers will also be focussing their energy on examination techniques and sharing model answers and guiding revision.
