## **Year 12 Transition to Year 13**

As your child completes their first year of Post 16 studies, we would like to outline their transition into Year 13. This is a very important time for your child who will be preparing for their progression to their chosen destination of university, apprenticeship or employment. This letter contains important information about your child's next steps.

### **University Visits**

We have arranged two university visits on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July to De Montfort University and the University of Birmingham to learn more about the UCAS process. The visits will allow students to experience university life, see typical student accommodation and talk to current undergraduate students. Lunch will be provided (free of charge) in the university canteen. Students will be accompanied by members of the Year 13 team. The dress code is casual.

On both days we will travel by coach, leaving at approximately 9.00am and returning by 3.10pm. The visit is provided free of charge by the university but we must ask all students to make a contribution of £15.00 each to cover the cost of coach travel to and from the university. Even if your child is not considering applying for university, we would encourage them to attend to allow them to confirm that decision. Our past experience suggests that students frequently change their mind about their future pathway throughout Year 13.

Please can you confirm your son/daughter's attendance by completing the attached reply slip and returning to School Reception by Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> June.
