It is the responsibility of **all** students to adhere to the Code of Conduct at **all** times for their own enjoyment and safety as well as that of others.

The following behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in students being removed from the prom and parents/carers will be contacted to collect:

- **Failure to follow instructions from school or hotel staff**
- **Purchase, possession or consumption of alcohol, drugs or tobacco/cigarettes (*before or during the Leavers' Prom*)**
- **Disorderly or violent conduct**
- **Disregard or damage to the property or possessions of others**

Please discuss the Code of Conduct and the school's expectations for behaviour during this event with your child.

Students attending the prom **MUST** sign the Code of Conduct agreement on Thursday 23 June 2022 after their GCSE exam. Parents/carers must sign also the Code of Conduct via the link above.
