Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope you and your family are well at this time.

We are writing to inform you that your child's Autumn Assessment Report has been sent to your email via Arbor. In the report you will have your child's Percentage Assessment and Percentage Class Average for their Autumn Assessments so that you can monitor your child's academic progress in subjects. We have also provided you with important pastoral information regarding your child's behaviour, attendance, punctuality and attitude in subjects. Please be aware that all data provided on this report is up to 6th December.

Attendance Data, Punctuality and Attendance Score

Alongside the attendance percentage we have included an attendance score (1-7) to provide you with a greater understanding of what the school expectations are for attendance. We have also included the number of late arrivals to school your child has had so far this year.

Behaviour Score - Aspire and Behaviour Points

We have provided you with the number of Aspire and Behaviour Points your child has received so far this year. Form tutors have individually reviewed each student's Aspire and Behaviour points to generate a Behaviour Score (1-7) that reflects the schools standards and expectations.

Subject Attitude Grade

Finally, we have provided you with a subject attitude score from 1-7 awarded by the class teacher for all subjects. This is based on engagement in lesson, contribution to class discussion and quality of homework and classwork completed.

Grading system

We have used a grading system from 1 (Very poor) to 7 (Outstanding), please see the table of grading descriptors below:

Score	Description
7	Outstanding behaviour for learning/attendance/attitude to learning
6	Excellent behaviour for learning/attendance/attitude to learning
5	Good behaviour for learning/attendance/attitude to learning
4	Acceptable behaviour for learning/attendance/attitude to learning
3	Behaviour/attendance/attitude to learning needs some improvement
2	Poor behaviour for learning/attendance/attitude to learning
1	Very poor behaviour for learning/attendance/attitude to learning
