Facilities in school	<p>Year 7 – explained there aren't enough toilets and that older years are using toilets in wrong blocks. Ms O'Connor explained if there are issues, then report to member of staff/leadership on duty. Ms O'Connor also advised that from next week (30th Jan), more toilets will be opened.</p> <p>Year 8 – Water fountains are not working properly. Mr Grieve (Site Manager) explained that the mechanisms for the fountains are really weak and therefore, easily broken. Mrs Heffernan (Business Manager) explained there are talks with companies for higher quality water fountains. Prefects will be getting involved with damage around school and reporting to studenthelpdesk@cncs.school. Ms O'Connor will be liaising with Mr Said regarding more posters around school on how to report damage.</p> <p>Year 9 – Sports Hall, Science and Art block floors are really dirty/dusty. Mrs Heffernan will speak to the cleaning company on this and students' will receive a formal response about this.</p> <p>Chewing gum issue – there is a potential to 'de-gum' tables, but Miss Cunningham will be planning (for the next student council pastoral session) a talking point around this issue.</p> <p>Sixth Form – Girls' toilets are broken/flushes are broken. Mr Grieve explained long term plans for toilets and Sixth Form is next on this list. There has been an update in regards to refurbishing the toilets e.g. being painted, stock replenished to make it a nicer area.</p>
Rewards	<p>Miss Cunningham is going to meet with Student Leadership about issuing rewards.</p> <p>Year 7 – lack of ASPIRE points being awarded, so students can't get their rewards. Ms O'Connor explained that the Rewards Shop is not a given and the behaviour data shows this (behaviour isn't improving). However, we will be moving back to ClassCharts for ASPIRE/Behaviour points after half term so this process is easier.</p> <p>Year 9 – 'false representation' of products – the rewards received are not like the images showcased. Ms O'Connor explained this will be reviewed.</p> <p>Post 16 – Sixth Form are not receiving enough ASPIRE points. Miss Goodwin will be reminding teaching staff about the 5 ASPIRE points policy for all year groups.</p>
Careers	<p>Students on the whole would like more careers focused days and more public sector representatives.</p> <p>Sixth Form would like workshops on UCAS, Finance etc earlier to prepare them. Miss Goodwin explained that this will be reviewed and discussed with the Sixth Form team.</p>

Trips/Enrichment	<p>Students would like more abroad trips. Ms O'Connor explained that this is completely down to staff uptake, but this will be spoken about with teaching staff.</p> <p>Big Day Out – students would like this to be brought back.
