Re: Standards-Uniform and equipment

Dear Parents/carers,

As we come to the end of our second term of the academic year we would like to wish all our students and families a wonderful Easter and thank students for their hard work this term.

We take the opportunity to remind parents/carers of the high standards we expect at school and the importance of ensuring that your child has the appropriate uniform and equipment ready for the start of the summer term returning on Monday 17th April.

Please note the following expectations for uniform and equipment:

- Black school shoes must be worn, no trainers.
- No Earrings, nose piercings, the only jewellery that is allowed is a watch.
- No nail Varnish or acrylic nails.
- No tight/cropped trousers or leggings- please see the uniform policy for acceptable trousers.
- No lycra/tight fitting skirts- skirts should be knee length and pleated.
- Blazers and jumpers are compulsory.
- Students should have a pencil case that includes- ball point pens (black or blue and green), pencils, ruler, sharpener, rubber, glue stick, calculator and highlighters.
- Students cannot have unnatural/bright coloured hair either due to dying or having hair braids.
- Coats must be black or navy, no hoodies, leather jackets or tracksuit tops.
